Dear Parents/Carers

I am sure you have all heard the recent news that The Department for Education is planning to continue the free school meals voucher scheme for eligible pupils. We know this has been a difficult time for families and communities and your circumstances may have changed.

Your child/ren may be entitled to free school meals and could benefit from the National Voucher Scheme allowing them to continue to access meals for their child/ren during the next four weeks up until February Half term 2021.

We are able to provide every eligible child a weekly shopping voucher worth £15 (which totals £60). The vouchers can be spent at the following supermarkets :-

If you believe that your child may be eligible for FSM, all you need to do is provide the following information by clicking the link below.

- Parent's First Name
- Parent's Last Name
- Parent's Date of Birth
- Parent's National Insurance Number

By providing your information for eligibility you are consenting to Dartington Primary School applying on your behalf; this information will not be used for any other purposes. If you are eligible then we will receive a certificate and we will be able to start ordering the FSM vouchers for your family.

If you are in receipt of one of the following, your child will be entitled to free school meals :-

- Universal Credit (provided you have an annual net earned income of no more than £7,400.
- Income Support (IS)
- Income-based Jobseekers Allowance (IRESA)
- The guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- Child Tax Credit (provided you're not also entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual gross income as assessed by HRMC that does not exceed £16,190)
- Working Tax Credit run-on (the payment you get for a further 4 weeks after you stop qualifying for Working Tax Credit)

**Those who are entitled will receive their vouchers by the end of this week.** Please do not hesitate to contact the office if you have any questions.
