Read Write Inc. E-Library

We have an exciting new resource to share with you on Oxford Owl: our Read Write Inc. E-Library. This will allow your child to read the book that they have been focusing on in their lessons with you, at home. Your child will already have read this book 2-3 times in class during the week and this is an opportunity for them to really show off to you how well they can read!

If your child is on the RWI programme, they will therefore have three different reading books each week that they can enjoy:

1. The online RWI book that they have been reading in class,
2. The story book or sound blending book linked to the sounds they have been learning in class (colour banded),
3. A 'reading for pleasure' book. This book will be one chosen by your child and may be above their reading level. This is one you could read to them or share together to enhance their love of reading as we know that reading for pleasure is the single most important indicator of a child's future success (OECD 2002).

Books will be allocated each week by your child's class teacher. The first online book will be allocated on the 20th March so that your child will have had the opportunity to read it in their RWI lessons first.

How to access our Read Write Inc E-Library

1. Go to www.oxfordowl.co.uk
2. Select Login for School and enter the login information provided on the card sent home by your child's class teacher.
