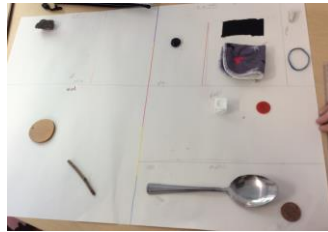

Dear Parents and Carers,

What a fantastic second week of term we have had. It has been great to see everyone settling into our new routines and we are so proud of everybody's enthusiasm and energy for learning.

This week we have been exploring a range of explanation texts in English, we have identified the features of this style of writing and how explanation texts are presented. In maths, we are learning about place value and learning about the value of numbers to 100,000. We have explored the properties of different materials in science and had lots of great discussions when categorising materials into different groups! Here are some photos sharing the different ways we grouped materials in our lesson.



We have our forest school session taught by Mrs Wallis on Wednesday mornings – wellies and waterproofs will be needed for these sessions. Our P.E. lessons will be on Thursday and Friday afternoons.
