Thank you so much to you all for taking time to speak to me this week during our parents' consultations. It has been great to have some valuable conversations to enable me to support your children in their learning and as they settle into year 4. If you weren't able to book an appointment this week and would still like a conversation at any point, please do get in touch. In our English learning this week, we have been planning ahead to writing our own explanation texts by creating our own environmental campaigns. It has been so heart-warming to see the children realising that taking a few small steps can have a huge impact; they are looking forward to sharing their campaigns with you and the wider community. In maths this week we have been rounding to 1000. Nia was such a great role model during this lesson using our sentence stem "I know that.... because..." to explain her mathematical thinking. We have also been learning about negative numbers

and finished the week looking at Roman numerals. The children had a particularly arty morning on Tuesday as they created designs for the Trust Christmas card competition (I know, Christmas always starts too soon in school!). They definitely showed our value of creativity when producing some amazing designs to fit with the theme of "Compassion at Christmas".



I know a number of parents have spoken to me

about needing a "parent code" to access google classroom. It is my understanding that this could be because google is defaulting to a different account (e.g. an old account or the account of another family member) when trying to access our Woodpeckers classroom.
