I hope you and your children all had a good break over half term. It seems that winter has really arrived in earnest this week with this cold weather, which has been a bit of a shock to us all! Due to the ongoing pandemic, just like last winter, we aim to keep the air flowing through classrooms as much as possible. For this reason, it is advisable to send your children in with warm clothing as it can be pretty chilly in the classroom in the mornings if we have to keep the windows open!

You may have noticed we have a new member of staff in class in the mornings. We were delighted when Mrs Merrington started with us at Dartington shortly before half term and she is with our class during registration time in order to help those children who need a bit of additional support settling in. Mrs Merrington is also based in our class in the afternoons and will be an extra "trusted adult" for your children to get to know and to go to for support; I know lots of them have worries and additional things going on and we always strive to meet each child's individual needs as effectively as possible.



In our learning this week, we have started out new English topic "writing to entertain..." We will be working towards writing our own stories with a castle setting, to link with our exiting new history topic of Medieval Britain. We will be particularly focusing on the history of Totnes and Dartingon and during our research, Mrs Davis discovered that there are 66 buildings/houses in the Totnes
