In our carpet time sessions we have been learning about the life cycle of a frog. We learnt that they begin as frogspawn and then become tadpoles. The tadpoles grow into froglets and then become adult frogs. The children could remember the vocabulary accurately and used their new information to write their own sentences! Our story this week has been 'Perfectly Norman' by Tom Percival. I wonder if your child can tell you what amazing thing happens to Norman?
