


## What is my child learning this half term?

Summer 2	Year 1/2
Class Novel	Each class will be choosing their own class novel this half term.
	Kingfishers: Pugs of the Frozen North - Philip Reeve and Sarah Mcintyre. (continuing from last half term) Starlings - Fizzlebert Stump - the boy who did P.E. in his pants Swallows - The Midnight Gang - David Walliams (continuing from last half term)
Writing	Our year 2s will be writing to inform this term. Their final outcome will be a biography of Queen Victoria.
Maths	Year 1 - We will begin by looking at fractions, focusing on halves and quarters, before moving on to place value to 100 and measure. Year 2 - Our focus will be on measuring weight, volume and temperature.
Science	This term we will be continuing our learning about plants by focusing on trees. We will be identifying deciduous and ever-green trees and learning the names of some of the most common trees found in our locality. This learning will be supported through our learning in Forest Schools.
RE	In Religious Education this term we will be answering the question 'How should we care for the world and for others, and why does it matter?
History	We will be learning about Queen Victoria and life in Victorian times. In particular we will focus on her Diamond Jubilee celebrations and compare them to Queen Elizabeth II's Platinum Jubilee celebrations.
PE	This summer term, we will be focusing on the skills needed to play Dartmoor 3 Ball. This will involve catching, striking a ball and running.
PSHE	We will be thinking about how we can recognise cycles of life in nature.
Forest School	Our Forest School is linked to our Science and we will be looking at trees in our local area.
Music	We will be using this half term to reflect and revisit some of the different music styles we have learnt this year. We will continue to use the glockenspiels and begin to read basic music.
D.T.	In D.T. we will be exploring how we can join different materials together including sewing. We will be designing our own bag or pencil case and then using these techniques to make it.
