

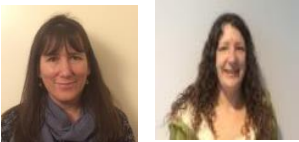

*All the Tawny Owls for their beautiful behaviour whilst out on our museum trip.*




