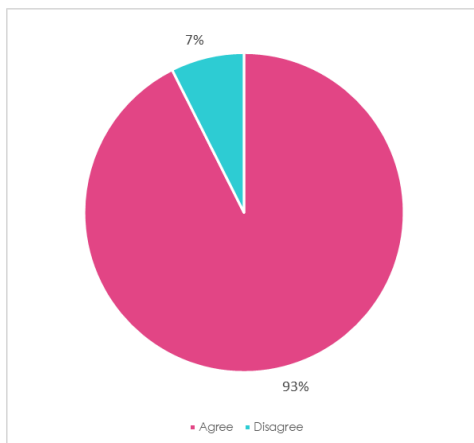

“My child loves coming to school and always comes out happy”

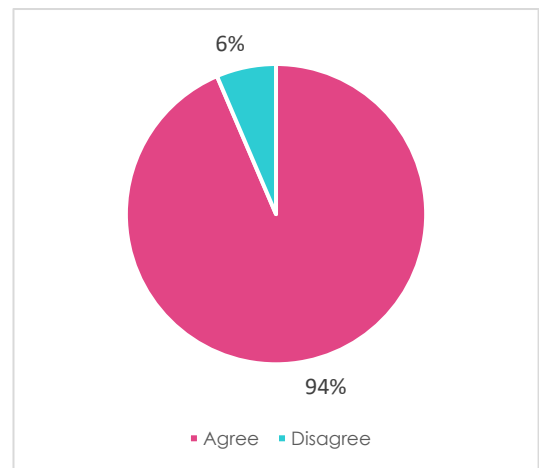
My child is happy at school

My child feels safe at school?



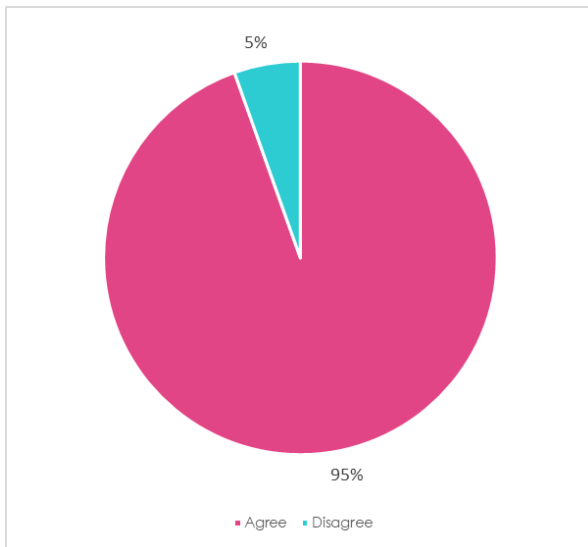

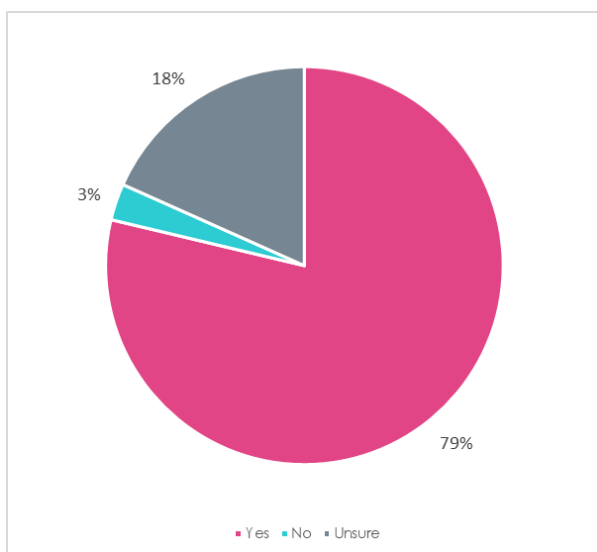


The school ensures its children are well behaved

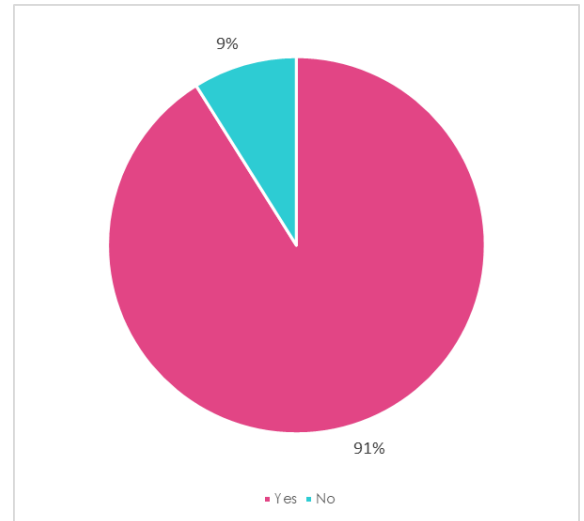


95% of you thought that our school ensures children are well behaved. This shows an increase and impact of our new relational approach.

The school's values have a good impact on my child

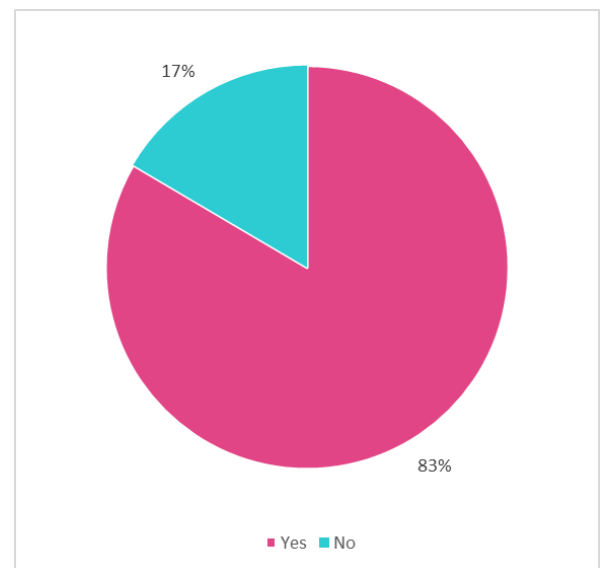


The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year



"I love the opportunity to come into school on the open afternoons and find out about the learning. Thank you!!"

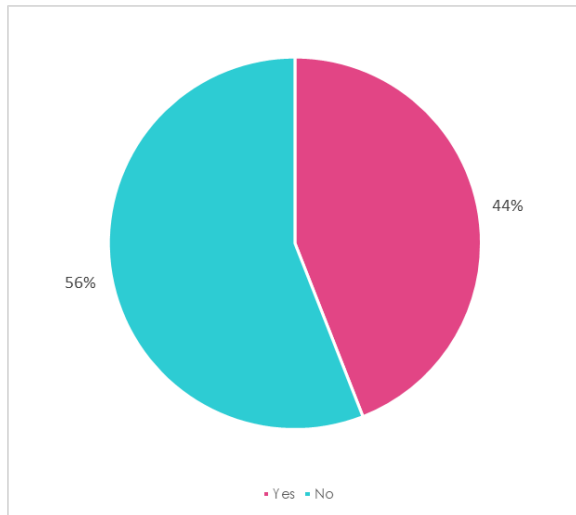
When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with correctly.



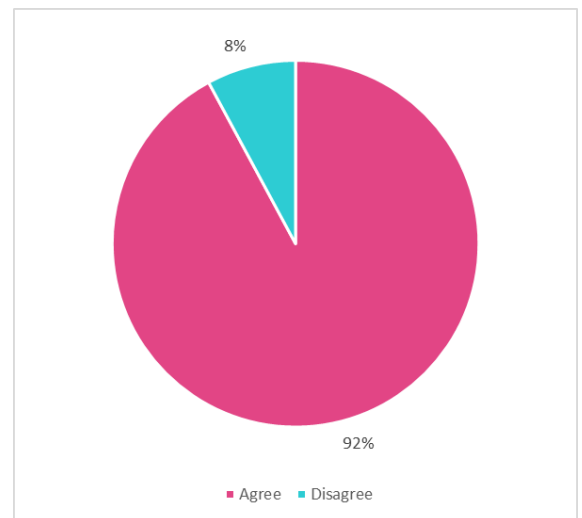

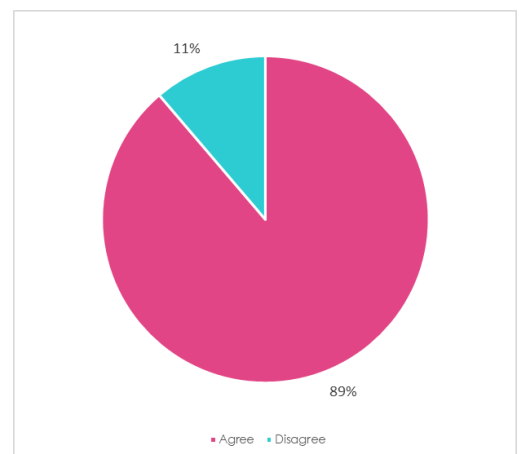
Does your child have Special Educational Needs and/or disabilities (SEND)?



How strongly do you agree with this statement? "My child has Special Educational Needs, and the school works in partnership with me, so that I know the support that the school gives to my child."



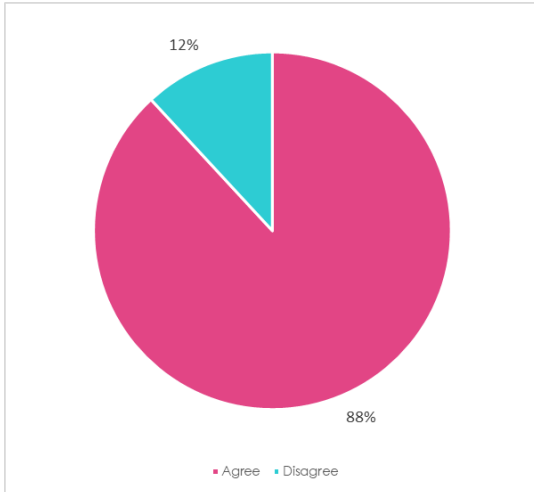

"The school have been fantastic in supporting my children. They are an amazing staff and I am so happy my children get the privilege of going to this school."

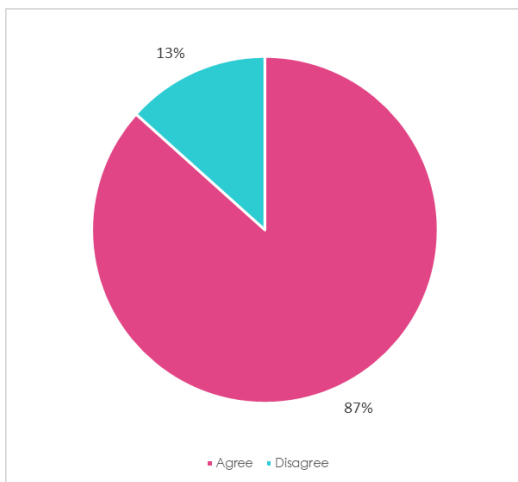


The school has high expectations for my child

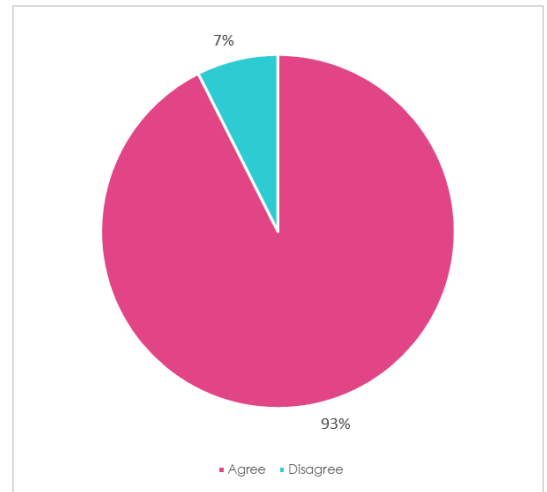

The school lets me now how my child is doing



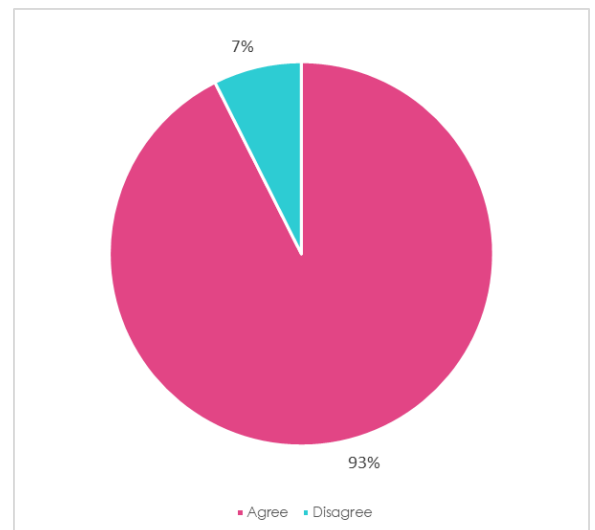
My child has access to the full range of national curriculum subjects

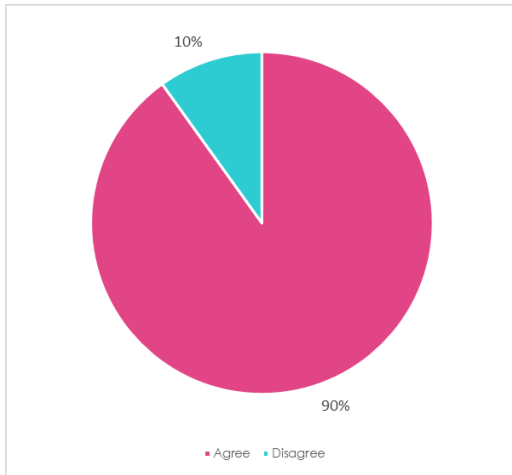


My child is flourishing at school





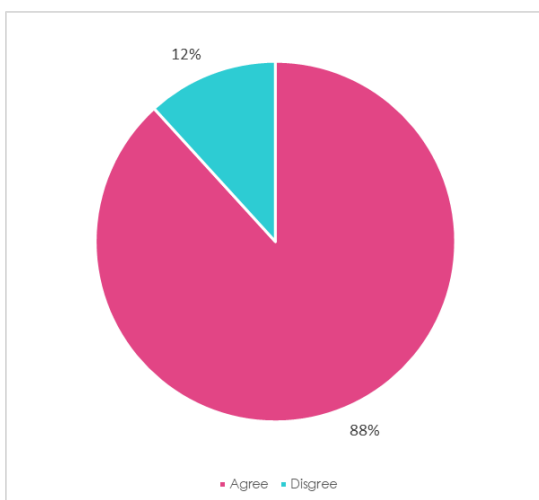
The school helps my child to take part in a wide range of activities, clubs and experiences



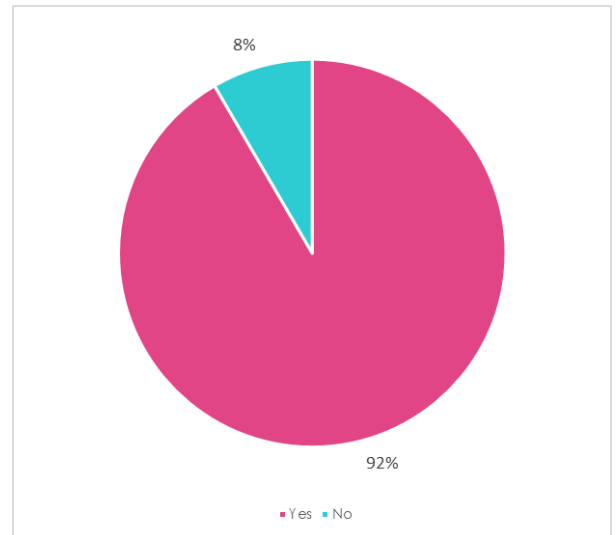
We are pleased that 90% feel that their school helps their child to take part in a wide range of experiences additional to the taught curriculum.
