Year 3 & 4 Animal Experience – Friday 4th April 2025

We are arranging an exciting animal themed day of learning, which links to our science unit of work, and we are keen to invite an animal expert as part of our broadening horizons mission.

We are lucky to have a great working relationship with Frazoo and they have kindly offered us a reduced rate for their education package. We have booked small workshops for class groups to experience hands on activities and opportunities with rare creatures as well as a whole unit assembly at the end of the day. Excitingly, the date coincides with our planned Curriculum Open Afternoon, so parents of Year's 3 and 4 are also invited to join us for our assembly fun.

Frazoo will teach us about food chains and prey/predators, adaptation and camouflage, skeletons and muscles, habitats, climate zones and classification through their multitude of interesting creatures and hands on activities.

The workshops will take place at School on **Friday 4<sup>th</sup> April 2025** and all our Year 3 and Year 4 children will take part. Parents, who are able to join us for our final assembly, can meet us in the hall from 2.15pm.

We have opted for an internal activity to try and keep costs to a minimum while still offering a bespoke and exciting curriculum to our children. Therefore, we are asking for a voluntary contribution of £2.25 to cover the cost of inviting Frazoo to share their expertise and knowledge. If we do not collect sufficient voluntary contributions, the Animal Experience may have to be cancelled. Payments can be made via the MCAS app by **Friday 14<sup>th</sup> March**.
