


## What is my child learning this half term?

Spr 1	Year 3/4

Class Novel	Each class will be choosing their own class novel this half term linked to their class preferences.
Writing	This half-term, we are focusing on writing to entertain. We will be creating our own suspenseful narratives using 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes as inspiration as well as 'The Secret of Black Rock' by Joe Todd-Stanton.
Maths	The Year 3 and 4 maths curriculum this term will continue our learning about fractions. We'll also explore measurement and length and perimeter.
Science	We will be learning about animals, including humans. We'll identify the different types of teeth in mammals and their simple functions, construct and interpret a variety of food chains as well as identify producers, predators and prey.
RE	This term we will be exploring Christianity and considering, 'Why do Christians call the day Jesus died 'Good Friday?' while deepening our understanding of Easter.
History	In history, we'll be learning about WW2. We will focus on the D-Day landings and their impact within our local area.
PE	Our PE topics this half-term are dodgeball and tag rugby. We'll enjoy building our team games skills as well as using our spatial awareness to aid us in our efforts to dodge and evade.
RHE	Our RHE learning will explore Media Literacy and Digital Resilience as well as a unit of learning thinking about Money and Work.
Forest School	In Forest School, we'll continue using all of our skills to explore the natural world. We'll enjoy creating nature crafts to celebrate the natural world around us.
Music	In music, we'll be preparing for our Easter service at the church as well continuing our recorder unit of learning 'Monster Monster'.
DT	In design and technology, we'll be using our textiles skills to help us turn 2D shapes into 3D shapes. We're going to be designing, making and evaluating drawstring bags.
